Red Light GO exploded onto the music scene in late-2006 after a chance meeting between lead singer Andy Madison and bass player Richie Jobson in a retro clothing shop on Gloucester Road, Bristol.

Formed around a mutual admiration of eyeliner, leopard-print and all things Sex Pistols they immediately set about headhunting well known local guitarist Paul Bradley, who had gathered a formidable reputation on the Bristol music scene for his dense and angry howls of guitar feedback and his ability to unflinchingly play every Van Halen solo behind his head.

After walking past Red Light GO's rehearsal room in East Bristol, Craig McAllister immediately quit his successful local band to add his soaring and earth-shattering synths to the band's exciting new sound.

Finally, Paul's younger brother Tom Bradley was invited to audition. Stunned by his thunderous and atomic drumming he was invited to complete the lineup.

RLG have played live radio sessions on both local and national radio including the **Radio 6** breakfast show and **Pulse Radio**. The band has headlined at some of the region's biggest venues and has received rave reviews for appearances at major local festivals. Energetic performances on the Main stage at **Ashton Court Festival** and the **Stroud Fringe Festival** have forced audiences to sit up and take notice, with the latter resulting in a now infamous stage invasion by excited youths.

Taking the best sounds and styles from the past and reinventing them for the future, they have been likened to the **Sex Pistols, David Bowie, T- Rex, Guns'n'Roses, The Clash, The Cure** and early **Manic Street Preachers**.
